Students and staff at **Assumption College High School** are raising the bar again this year as they host their 9th Canadian Cancer Society *Relay For Life* event in May. They're letting people living with cancer in the community know that they are not alone in their fight against the disease. To date, Assumption College students have managed to raise close to a half million dollars for the cause.

The Canadian Cancer Society *Relay For Life* is a 12-hour, overnight, non-competitive event that involves teams of 10 who take turns walking or running around a track. The event opens with the Survivors' Victory Lap, a "once around the track" for people who have survived cancer. At dusk, the Luminary Ceremony takes place, allowing people to honour others who have been touched by cancer by lighting candles that are placed around the track.

"*Relay For Life* is a meaningful way for high school students, teachers and staff to show family and friends affected by cancer that, together, we have the power to make a difference against this disease,"

"The event is also filled with hope as it gives our community an opportunity to celebrate cancer survivors and honour the memory of those who have been touched by the disease."
