Preparing for College

- College programs require only the prerequisites for the program

Example -Practical Nursing diploma

- one grade 12 English (C or U level)
- one senior biology (C or U level)
- one senior chemistry (C or U level)
- one grade 12 math (C or U level)

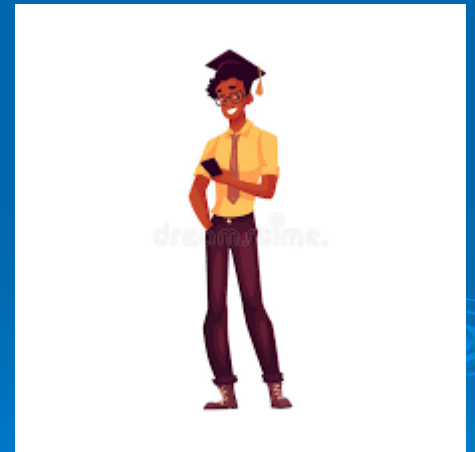


Preparing for University

- University programs ALWAYS require 6 grade 12 university (u) level or mixed level (m) courses.

Example - Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) degree

- Grade 12 university English
- Grade 12 university biology
- Grade 12 university chemistry
- Any grade 12 university level math
- 2 more grade 12 u/m level courses



Cooperative Education

- ½ day in a work placement off of school property
- Helps you to decide what you want to do
- Gives you experience needed for some post-secondary programs (concurrent teaching, social services etc.)
- Apprenticeship hours - OYAP Program (Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program)
- **BEFORE** choosing – decide transportation plan
- If you are choosing Co-Op pick up registration sheet at the end of this presentation.

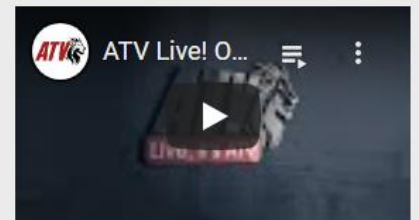
