First Day of Classes	Tuesday, September 6, 2022	This will be a full day of classes and you are required to be in full uniform.

Locks & Lockers	Locks: For security reasons, all students MUST use a lock which they have purchased from Assumption College. Locks are purchased via School Cash Online for \$12 up to September 1. Those locks will be delivered to homeroom classes.  Lockers: The Locker Number will be indicated on your timetable or distributed in their home room.	If you use a lock other than one from the school, it will be cut off the locker and your belongings will be removed and placed in the Vice Principals' office.

Student I.D. Cards	Photo Day is on September 22 <sup>nd</sup> . ID cards are issued shortly after. Photo retake day is October 27 <sup>th</sup> .	All students must have their photo taken for identification purposes, regardless of whether or not they purchase a photo pkg.
