#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

To be eligible for the BRREA 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary \$7,500 Scholarship, each applicant must:

- ❖ Have a permanent residence within the Brantford or Brant County Area.
- ❖ Be a graduating high-school student enrolled full-time (6 credits within the school year).
- ❖ Be in a Brant County or Brantford high school at the time of their application.
- ❖ Show proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution.
- Submit applications through the candidate's high school or directly to BRREA's Chief Executive Officer, Mike Carson.
- ❖ Following the completion of the 1<sup>st</sup> year in their post-secondary education, proof of further enrollment of studies must be sent to BRREA to receive the second installment of the scholarship funds.

Applicants must submit a complete application packet, which includes the following:

- 1. Application Form
- 2. A submission of  $\underline{\mathbf{1}}$  of the following options in answer to the topic below:
  - a. A typed 750-word essay;
  - b. A maximum 5-minute unbranded video (submission may not identify the candidate in any way); or
  - c. A graphic design project.

Formats may include Word or PDF documents, printed material, USB key or DVD. Graphic design submissions may be in any medium.

Topic: "With a changing population producing new communities, there are many considerations to be addressed in making these communities successful. Describe a key consideration that you feel needs to be addressed for success within the Brant County Area."

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINES:**

The BRREA 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary \$7,500 Scholarship deadline is Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

- \* Essay and video applications and supporting materials must be in **one packet** and submitted to the candidate's high school or directly to BRREA's Chief Executive Officer, Mike Carson.
- ❖ Graphic design applications and supporting materials must be delivered directly to BRREA's Chief Executive Officer, Mike Carson at 106 George St., Brantford.
- ❖ All application materials must be <u>received by BRREA no later than 5 p.m.</u> <u>Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018.</u>
- Only 1 submission from any candidate is permitted.
- Submissions will not be returned.
- **&** Branded submissions will not be accepted.
- **Each** applicant will be notified of the outcome of their submission:
  - o Winner's name will also be posted on the BRREA website and through various other media.
  - o Awards will be distributed with confirmation of enrollment in an accredited college, university, technical or trade school.
  - o Non-winners will be sent a letter of appreciation from the BRREA Scholarship committee.
