The Bursary is open to graduating students (male or female) who are planning some form of post-secondary education. They must reside in Brant County or live with a member of a Brant District Women's Institute branch (St George WI, Alford & Park Road WI, Cathcart WI, Women Inspiring Women WI-Paris) and be sponsored by 2 Women's Institute members in good standing. All Brant District Branches can sponsor applicants and have application forms available.
