Actions taken as a result of your survey feedback:

- Acquire support for staff to identify adolescent stress and anxiety
- Creation of a wellness centre to provide school supports (social worker, SST, special education department head) and assist with timely connection to community supports.
- FNMI advisory group created to tap into student voice.
- We All Belong initiatives tackle student-identified barriers to inclusiveness.
