First Day of Classes	Tuesday, September 4, 2018	This will be a full day of classes and you are required to be in full uniform.
*Timetables	Timetables will be distributed to students on Thursday, August 30 and Friday, August 31, 2018 from 9am to 3pm in the school cafeteria. <u>Timetables will</u> <u>not be distributed to anyone who has not returned</u> <u>their student verification forms</u> . Locks & Lockers	 Locks: For security reasons, all students MUST use a lock which they have purchased from Assumption College. Locks are purchased at the school office for \$10 beginning August 30. Lockers: The Locker Number will be indicated on your timetable. 	If you use a lock other than one from the school, it will be cut off the locker and your belongings will be removed and placed in the Vice Principals' office.
Student Agenda	Student agendas will be distributed to all Grade 9s in their homerooms in September.	All school policies and procedures and the student agenda contents are available on our website www.assumptionlions.com .
School Calendar	The <i>calendar</i> includes important information for students and parents alike.	Student calendars will be distributed to students at timetable pick-up.
Student I.D. Cards	Photo Day is on September 20 th . ID cards are issued shortly after. Photo retake day is October 25 th .	<u>All</u> students must have their photo taken for identification purposes, regardless of whether or not they purchase a photo pkg.
Student Internet Ethics and Acceptable Use Policy Agreement	 Board Policy requires that all students must have a signed Student Internet Ethics and Acceptable Use Policy - Agreement to Comply form on file BEFORE using any school computer equipment. You should have completed this form when you registered. If you have not completed the form, blank forms will be available when you pick up your timetable. 	If you do not submit a signed form, you will not be able to use any computer equipment in the school. Once your signed form is submitted, you will be given your computer login and password. This will be found on your timetable.

Transportation	Students who drive themselves must park in the STUDENT PARKING LOT only and MUST have a valid parking permit obtained from the vice-principal's office.
