First Day of Classes	Tuesday, September 5, 2017	This will be a full day of classes and you are required to be in full uniform.
*Timetables	Timetables will be distributed to students on the first day of school in their homerooms once they have returned their student verification forms (in Grade 9 welcome mailings or Report Card mailings for current students).	Students will be emailed their homeroom teacher and locations on Friday, September 1, 2017.  Grade 10-12 students are to report to their homerooms on the first day to receive their full timetables.  Grade 9 students will report to the cafeteria where they will meet their homeroom teachers.  Step-by-step instructions on how to access your student email are on the back of this page.
Locks & Lockers	Locks: For security reasons, all students <b>MUST use a lock</b> which they have purchased from Assumption College. Locks are purchased at the school office for \$10 beginning August 23rd.  Lockers: The Locker Number will be indicated on your timetable.	If you use a lock other than one from the school, it will be cut off the locker and your belongings will be removed and placed in the Vice Principals' office.
Student Agenda	Student agendas will be distributed to all Grade 9s in September.	All school policies and procedures are available on our website www.assumptionlions.com.
School Calendar	The calendar includes important information for students and parents alike.	Student calendars will be available in homerooms on the first day of school.
Student I.D. Cards	Photo Day is on September 21 <sup>st</sup> . ID cards are issued shortly after. Photo retake day is October 26 <sup>th</sup> .	All students must have their photo taken for identification purposes, regardless of whether or not they purchase a photo pkg.

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Student Internet Ethics and Acceptable Use Policy Agreement	Board Policy requires that all students must have a signed Student Internet Ethics and Acceptable Use Policy Agreement - Agreement to Comply form on file BEFORE using any school computer equipment.  You should have completed this form when you registered. If you have not completed the form, blank forms will be available when you pick up your timetable.	If you do not submit a signed form, you will not be able to use any computer equipment in the school.  Once your signed form is submitted, you will be given your computer login and password. This will be found on your timetable.
Transportation	Students who drive themselves must park in the STUDENT PARKING LOT only and MUST have a valid parking permit obtained from the vice-principal's office.	Transportation information for the 2017-2018 school year will be made available to view at <a href="https://www.stsbhn.ca">www.stsbhn.ca</a> after August 15, 2017. Please check their student portal to determine bus location and time.
